

Accessibility Statement for Alwoodley Parish Council

Scope

Alwoodley Parish Council is committed to ensuring digital accessibility for people with disabilities.

We are actively working to improve the user experience for everyone and to meet the requirements of the **Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) Accessibility Regulations 2018**, which are based on the **Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2**.

We know that some parts of this website are not yet fully accessible, and we have set out below the actions we will take during 2025 to make improvements.

Measures to Support Accessibility

Alwoodley Parish Council will take the following steps during 2025 to ensure its website becomes more accessible:

- Add descriptive **alt text** for all meaningful images and remove or hide decorative ones.
- Ensure all **PDFs, agendas, and minutes** are uploaded in accessible formats.
- Review and update **page headings** for logical structure and clear navigation.
- Improve **colour contrast** and font readability where needed.
- Review and simplify the **newsletter sign-up form** to ensure it can be used by screen readers.
- Add a new **Accessibility Statement** and **Privacy & Cookies Policy** written in plain English.
- Publish an internal **Accessibility Action Plan** and review progress quarterly.
- Provide a contact option for users to request documents in alternative formats.
- Carry out a full **accessibility check** using WAVE and Lighthouse tools before December 2025.

Conformance Status



This website aims to meet **WCAG 2.2 Level AA** standards.

Currently, it is **partially compliant**, meaning some content does not yet fully meet accessibility requirements.

Work is underway during 2025 to address the areas listed above.
